REASON STATEMENT AND FISCAL IMPACT						
Not all basements are subject to damp or wet conditions. Expanding GFCI coverage to all areas of finished basements even where no water is to be expected is not justified. Finished areas of basements are not as hazardous as bathrooms or kitchens where people use small appliances near sinks and tubs. As written, this would affect all new houses and older homes which have their basement electrical systems updated or expanded.  This proposed code change was approved by the 2020 NEC Review Committee (proposal #95).  Fiscal Impact: \$483,900 (4839 x \$100) for class 2 structures (one-and two-family dwellings and townhouses); assumes 1/3 of homes have basements (7,259) and of those, 2/3 (4839) are unfinished
