NON-FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter was set for a telephonic initial prehearing conference on December 9, 2020 and the Petitioner failed to appear for the initial prehearing conference. The Respondent agreed to give the Petitioner an opportunity to reschedule and the ALJ left Petitioner a voice message and sent an email to Petitioner advising him that he missed the initial prehearing conference and he may reschedule by contacting the ALJ. On December 17, 2020, the ALJ sent a second email to the representative for Petitioner and advised that he had until close of business on December 18, 2020 to reschedule, otherwise the ALJ would issue a proposed order of default or dismissal. The ALJ did not receive a response from Petitioner and accordingly issued a Proposed Order of Dismissal on December 21, 2020. The Petitioner then responded on December 21, 2020, stating that he was unable to respond and reschedule due to illness and asked how to proceed. The ALJ provided information regarding Petitioner's options and a template that Petitioner could utilize to respond to the Proposed Order of Dismissal.

The timeline set out in the Proposed Order of Dismissal was seven (7) days to file a response. To date, the Petitioner has not submitted a response. Accordingly, the ALJ issues this Non-Final Order of Dismissal. The ALJ has enclosed with this Non-Final Order of Dismissal a complete record of proceedings and correspondence between the ALJ and the parties for reference.

Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-29(d) requires any party seeking to preserve an objection to this order for judicial review to file the objection with the Commission within fifteen (15) days after the service of this order. The objection must be in writing and must identify the basis for the objection with reasonable particularity.

In the absence of an objection from a party or notice from the Commission of its intent to review any issue related to this order, the Commission shall affirm this order in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29(c). **The Commission will consider this Non-Final Order of Dismissal on February 2, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.** at the Indiana State Library, Room 211, 315 W. Ohio Street, Indianapolis, IN 46202. If the Commission's meeting must be conducted electronically/remotely due to the ongoing COVID-19 public health emergency, details will be provided on the Commission main web page (http://www.in.gov/dhs/2375.htm) in advance of the meeting date.

The parties were also advised that any party who fails to attend or participate in a prehearing conference, hearing, or other later stage of the proceeding may be held in default or have the proceeding dismissed pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3-24.

The ALJ did not receive any correspondence from the parties in advance of the scheduled initial prehearing conference. On the scheduled date and time of the initial prehearing conference, the ALJ contacted the Respondent's counsel, Justin Guedel, and then attempted to reach the Petitioner's representative at the phone number above. Mr. Curtis did not answer, so the ALJ also tried contacting him at the Five Star Dive Bar main office but did not receive an answer and therefore left a voice message. The ALJ then emailed Mr. Curtis at iasonkzk@gmail.com and advised that he should reach out at his earliest convenience to reschedule. To date, the ALJ has not received any communication from Mr. Curtis. On December 17, 2020, the ALJ followed up a second time via email and advised that a default order would be issued in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-24 for failure to attend or participate in a prehearing conference, hearing, or other stage of the proceeding if a request to reschedule was not made before close of business on December 18, 2020. The ALJ did not receive such a request and issues this Proposed Order of Dismissal accordingly.

As it is the Petitioner in this matter who has failed to participate, it is appropriate to issue a dismissal rather than a default order. The Petitioner will have seven (7) days to file a motion requesting that the proposed default order not be imposed and stating the grounds for the request. If the ALJ does not receive a motion from Petitioner within seven (7) days, the ALJ will issue a Non-Final Order of Dismissal, recommending that the Ultimate Authority dismisses this matter without prejudice.
