Explain:	The exterior hood vents and rooftop HVAC units were designed by Tom Allen, an Indiana licensed architect (AR0003852), of Susan May Allen Architects. According to the architect's plans and specifications and Tenant's contract with the architectural firm, the design comports with state and local laws. Indeed, no governmental entity advised as to this issue until immediately prior to the final certificate of occupancy was to be issued. In addition, numerous more recently constructed adjacent buildings have similar HVAC and rooftop exhaust vents without ladder and railing systems. See the attached photos. Accordingly, the Landlord and Tenant are subject of selective enforcement of this law. Finally, the applicants due process rights were violated as they did not have notice of the proposal or an opportunity to be heard. The variance application was tabled 8-9 times. When it came up for hearing, neither the Landlord nor the Tenant received notice that it would be considered at the August 2018 hearing.


