

- 9. All employees are expected to be trained in all aspects of Intertek's QA/QC program relative to their function.



10. Employees engaged in field inspection services must be monitored in-plant or on-site a minimum of once every three years, by the inspection supervisor.

Procedure:

QA/QC Training:

A detailed review of the Quality System is performed with the Manager, as well as all QA/QC relevant to their job (e.g., usage of logbooks, proper protocols for accurate record keeping, complaint handling protocols, etc.).

Certification Specific Training:

For the Professional Engineers their credentials constitute authorization for them to perform evaluation activities, other than in-plant auditing, for certification projects. For this task, the in-plant auditor training must be completed. For all others, the in-plant auditor or manager training will need to be documented prior to working on the projects.

Inspection Specific Training:

Inspectors must read and be familiar with the Intertek Inspection Procedure manual and the product design Manual. Training for each new inspector shall include an introductory period appropriate to his/her documented prior knowledge and experience. During this time, he/she must be accompanied by their supervisor or an experienced inspector during initial factory inspections until the supervisor is satisfied with their competence. Inspectors are formally authorized after successful training completion.

In addition, all inspectors shall participate in monthly inspector webinars for continuing training to keep pace with developing technology and inspection methods.

Unsatisfactory results may require re-training. The trainee is deemed competent by the trainer when they produce satisfactory results. Until properly trained, the trainee shall only perform such functions under the direct supervision of the supervisor.
