

- TABE 11&12 Reading content reflects mature, life-and work-related situations and highlights overlapping objectives, from word-meaning skills to critical-thinking skills
- TABE 11&12 Mathematics reflects math application, particularly routine tasks such as estimating quantities and making computations involving time, distance, weight, etc.
- TABE 11 & 12 Language assesses skills in grammar, usage, mechanics, sentence formation, and paragraph development. Understanding of word meaning and relationships, context, spelling, capitalization and punctuation in sentences, phrases, and clauses is included. Items are presented in meaningful contexts that reflect the writing process as it is applied in life.



New Information for NRS Reporting

Last week DWD was notified of a change on how Enrollment and HSEs are counted for the end of a Program Year.

Example – A student is enrolled in PY 2016-17 and earns the HSE in PY 2017-18. Guidelines initially indicated that if the student did <u>not</u> earn the HSE by June 30 the outcome would <u>not</u> count. The same student gets at least **ONE hour** of attendance in PY 2017-18; however, now the HSE will count because of the continued Period of Participation.





New Information for NRS Reporting

This also applies to the 12 hours of enrollment for students in the current term.

The NRS tables were changed to only count students with 12 hours in the current year and were <u>not</u> counting any student that had some hours in the previous year and some in the current term, which then totaled 12.


