 - Remember the folder should have a name that clearly identifies the applicant

Program Orientation – Counting Students

- Enter <u>all</u> students into InTERS once they enter the program for orientation
 - Count "every student because every student counts"
 - Students from orientation to enrollment will <u>not</u> be counted in performance numbers

- Column E
 - Number Attained an HSE/Equivalent
- Column H

Column H = Column D + Column E

Measurable Skill Gains by Entry Level

- Column I
 - Total number of periods of participation
- Column J
 - Total number of periods of participation with MSGs
- Column K
 - Percentage of periods of participation with MGGs

Remember a new Period of Participation is counted each time a participant exits and enters again, even if it occurs during the same program year. Exit is calculated 90 days after the date of last attendance.





The Importance of AmeriCorps

This year, AmeriCorps will provide more than **980** individuals the opportunity to provide intensive, results-driven service to meet education, environmental, health, economic, and other pressing needs in communities across Indiana. AmeriCorps State grant funding goes to the **Serve Indiana**, which in turn awards grants to nonprofit organizations, schools, government entities, and universities to respond to local needs.

Since 1994, more than **16,000 Indiana** residents have served more than **21** million hours and have qualified for Segal AmeriCorps Education Awards totaling more than **\$49,390,000**.

Annual Self-Monitoring | Formal Evaluation

HSE Monitoring

- Test coordinators at HSE test centers are required to annually selfmonitor <u>all</u> locations, including addendum sites, using the attached monitoring form between July 1 and June 30.
- Monitoring forms must be submitted to DWD via <u>adulted@dwd.in.gov</u>
- Test centers will be visited by DWD a minimum of once every three years for compliance





Professional Development



Policy/Waiver Request Process

- Teachers and instructional aides working nine (9) or more hours per week in adult education <u>must</u> complete a minimum of one (1) DWD AE sponsored professional development initiative annually
- Teachers and instructional aides may seek exemption to this training requirement (a minimum of 10 hours in length) if they participate in similar or more extensive professional development within the program year
 - PD Waiver Request Form available at www.AmplifyAE.org must be submitted <u>no</u> later than **April 29** of each program year


