The Division of Aging is pleased to announce it has engaged Milliman to review DA's home-and community-based services rates and to conduct rate methodology that is expected to culminate in the submission of waiver amendments.

DA and Milliman's rate methodology process includes the following:

1. Project and stakeholder engagement planning
2. Rate methodology development to achieve DA goals and objectives
3. Rate setting and calculations based on final selected rate methodologies
4. Waiver/state plan amendments and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services approval process

Balanced input from the full range of stakeholders is critical to this process. DA wants to hear from a variety of stakeholders, including providers and associations, participants, families, caregivers and advocacy groups, and other key stakeholders.
