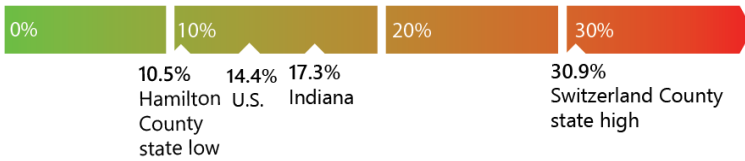

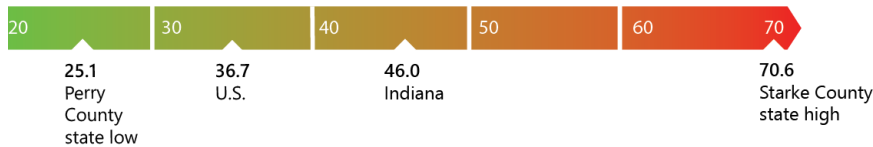
There is no tobacco control grant in Boone County for 2023-2025.

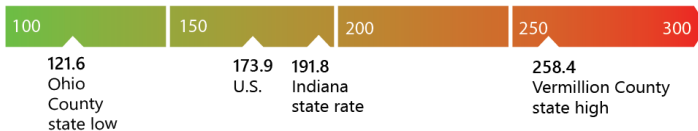
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **12.1%**



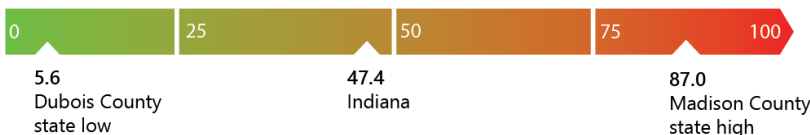
 **Lung cancer deaths** **41.9**
