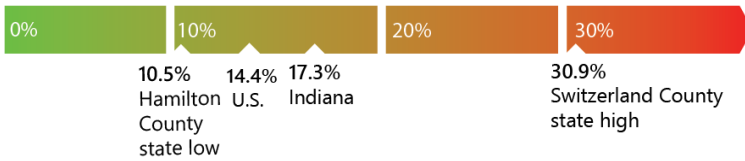

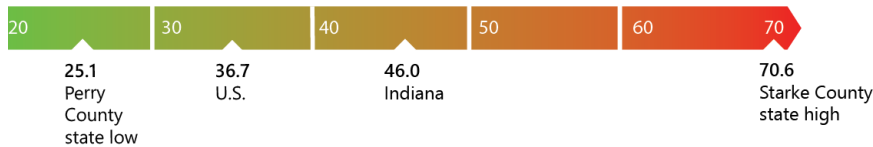
There is no tobacco control grant in Dubois County for 2023-2025.

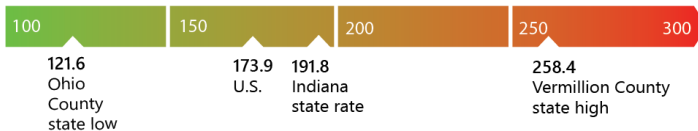
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **15.3%**



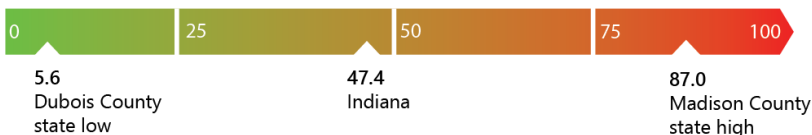
