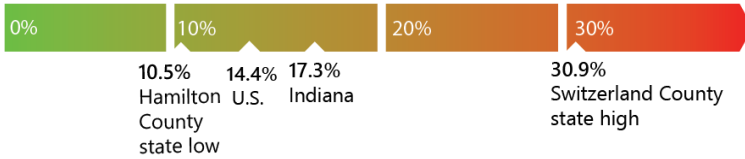

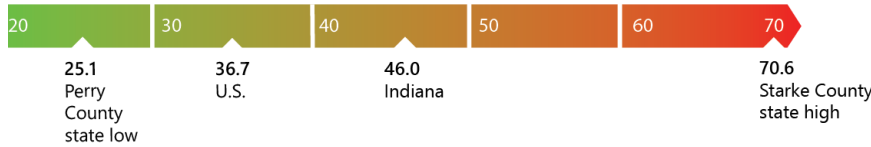

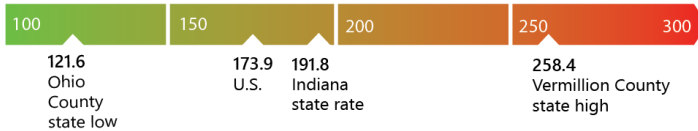
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **22.3%**



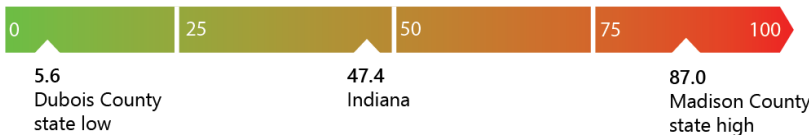
