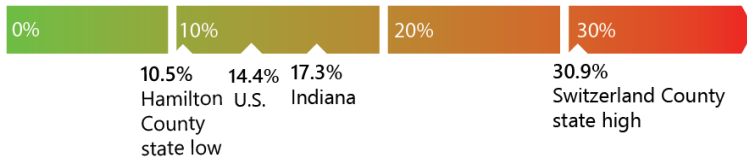

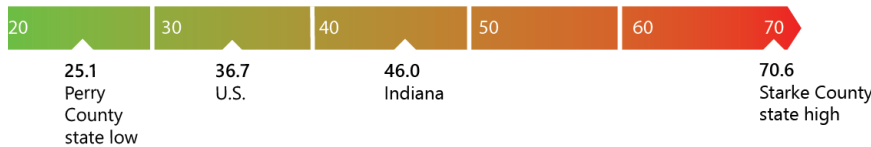
Percent of adults who smoke

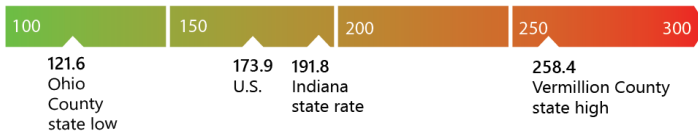

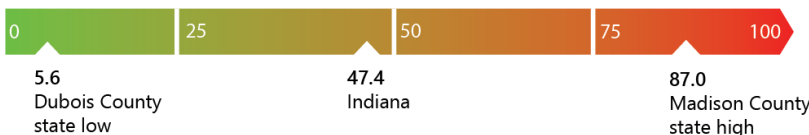
