

RESOLUTION 1995- 30

**A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE REQUEST
OF PLAYERS MICHIGAN CITY, INC. TO
WITHDRAW ITS APPLICATION FOR
A RIVERBOAT OWNER'S LICENSE**

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. Players Michigan City, Inc. submitted an application to obtain a riverboat owner’s license to be docked in Michigan City, LaPorte County, Indiana.
2. Players Michigan City, Inc. filed a written request, received by the Commission on September 8, 1995, to withdraw its application for a riverboat owner’s license to be docked in Michigan City, LaPorte County, Indiana. (copy of letter attached).
3. An applicant for a riverboat owner’s license must seek leave of the Commission to withdraw its application for a riverboat owner’s license. IC 4-33-5-2; 68 IAC 2-1-4(f).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC 1-1 apply to this resolution.

SECTION 2. ACTION ON REQUEST TO WITHDRAW.

The Request to Withdraw the application for a riverboat owner’s license to be docked in Michigan City, LaPorte County received from Players Michigan City, Inc. received on September 8, 1995, is hereby granted, effective October 17, 1995.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This resolution is effective immediately.


