

RESOLUTION 1999-23

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE REQUEST OF WICO CORPORATION TO WITHDRAW ITS APPLICATION FOR A SUPPLIER'S LICENSE.

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6:

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. On or about June 1, 1995, Wico Corporation submitted an application for a supplier's license to the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission").
2. On or about April 12, 1996, the Commission received a written request from Wico Corporation whereby Wico Corporation requested the ability to withdraw its application for a Supplier's License (copy of letter attached).
3. Wico Corporation was in good standing with the Commission at the time of the request to withdraw application and there are no pending disciplinary actions filed against Wico Corporation by the Commission.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to WICO Corporation.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. REQUEST TO WITHDRAW.

The request of Wico Corporation to withdraw its application for a Supplier's License, received on or about April 12, 1996, is hereby:
