RESOLUTION 2000-1

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO 68 IAC 3-3-3 AS AN EMERGENCY RULE

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The Commission has considered the following factors:

- 1. Pursuant to IC 4-33-4-3 and IC 4-22-2-37.1, the Commission has the authority to adopt emergency rules. The Commission is to commence rulemaking procedures not later than thirty (30) days after the adoption of the emergency rule.
- 2. A notice of intent to adopt this rule was published in the January 1, 2000 edition of the *Indiana Register*. While the emergency rule is in effect, the Commission will proceed with the formal rulemaking procedures set forth in IC 4-22-2 so that the amendment may be formally adopted before the emergency rule expires.
- 3. The Commission staff will file the adopted emergency rule with the Secretary of State and submit it for publication with the Legislative Services Agency. The emergency rule will become effective February 1, 2000, and will continue to be effective for ninety (90) days thereafter. The Commission will have the option to renew the effectiveness of the emergency rule for an additional ninety (90) days pending the formal promulgation process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to each applicant, each licensee, each riverboat license applicant, any person who does business with an applicant or licensee, and any person who is a patron of a Riverboat Gambling Operation.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. ADOPTION OF THE EMERGENCY RULE.

The Commission adopts the following rule as an emergency rule and for publication as a proposed rule:

Article 3 Minority and Women's Business Enterprises 68 IAC 3-3-3 Goals

Pursuant to IC 4-22-2-37.1, the Commission adopts this rule as an emergency rule. The Commission further adopts any stylistic, grammatical, typographical, or other nonsubstantive changes that the Commission or the Legislative Services Agency may make to this emergency rule. The Commission shall submit the rule to the Publisher of the *Indiana Register* and the Indiana Administrative Code for the assignment of a document control number and then shall submit the emergency rule to the Secretary of State for filing. The Commission will expeditiously complete the process necessary to adopt the emergency rule as a final rule pursuant to the dictates of IC 4-22-2.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The emergency rule adopted in section 3 of this resolution is to become effective February 1, 2000.

SECTION 5. EXPIRATION DATE.

This RESOLUTION expires ninety (90) days from the date of adoption.
