

RESOLUTION 2002-20

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE REQUEST OF V.S.R. LOCK, INC. TO WITHDRAW ITS SUPPLIER'S LICENSE

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The following factors have been considered by the Commission:

1. The Commission issued a temporary Supplier's License to V.S.R. Lock, Inc. ("VSR") on April 15, 1997, by RESOLUTION 1997-15.
2. The Commission issued a permanent Supplier's License to VSR on August 20, 1999, by RESOLUTION 1999-20.
3. The Commission renewed VSR's Supplier's License on August 21, 2000, by RESOLUTION 2000-28 and on August 23, 2001, by RESOLUTION 2001-28.
4. Pursuant to correspondence dated July 10, 2002, VSR requested that the Commission re-evaluate whether or not VSR should be required to continue to maintain a supplier's license. VSR previously had a gaming division that distributed gaming equipment. VSR has since the sold its gaming division but it will continue to supply non-gaming products.
5. On July 25, 2002, VSR requested the ability to withdraw its Supplier's License (copy of letter attached).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING
COMMISSION THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:**

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to VSR.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. REQUEST TO WITHDRAW.

The request of VSR to withdraw its Supplier's License is hereby:


