

RESOLUTION 2003-29

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE RENEWAL OF THE SUPPLIER'S LICENSE HELD BY SIGMA GAME, INC.

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6:

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. Sigma Game, Inc. ("Sigma") was issued a temporary supplier's license on February 12, 1996 and a permanent supplier's license on June 12, 1998. The license was renewed on June 12, 2002.
2. In accordance with IC 4-33-7-8 and 68 IAC 2-2-8, a supplier's license must be renewed annually.
3. Sigma has requested a renewal of licensure and the renewal fee has been paid in accordance with 68 IAC 2-2-3(c) and 68 IAC 2-2-8.
4. Sigma has entered into a settlement agreement with the Missouri Gaming Commission ("MGC") regarding a disciplinary action for violations of MGC regulations. Although the allegations are of a serious nature, they were not of a nature that would cause Commission staff to recommend revocation or non-renewal of Sigma's supplier's license. The Commission's Background Investigation Unit is conducting an investigation into the issues surrounding the Missouri disciplinary action to determine if Indiana regulations have also been violated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This resolution applies to Sigma Game, Inc.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3. CONDITIONS PLACED ON SUPPLIER'S LICENSE.

1. The renewal of Sigma's supplier's license is hereby conditioned upon the resolution of the issues surrounding the Missouri disciplinary action. Should the Commission discover that Indiana gaming regulations were

violated or that Sigma failed to suitably conduct business pursuant to IC 4-33 or 68 IAC, the Commission may take further action against Sigma's supplier's license.

2. Sigma will be responsible for paying any background investigation fees associated with the Commission's investigation. If payment is not received as directed by Commission staff, the supplier's license will be subject to revocation.
3. In the future, if Sigma wishes to renew its supplier's license, it must request renewal of the supplier's license at least thirty (30) days before the expiration of the license and pay the renewal fee in accordance with 68 IAC 2-2-3(c) and 68 IAC 2-2-8.

SECTION 4. GRANT OF RENEWAL OF SUPPLIER'S LICENSE.


The Commission hereby grants the renewal of Sigma's supplier's license subject to the conditions stated in Section 3 of this Resolution. The renewed supplier's license will be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of issuance. Failure on the part of Sigma to meet the conditions set forth in this Resolution or comply with IC 4-33 or rules promulgated thereunder will result in appropriate Commission action.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Resolution is effective immediately.
