AS FINAL RULES.**

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. The Commission has begun promulgation of these rules pursuant to IC 4-22. These rules were published as proposed rules in the July 1, 2004 edition of the *Indiana Register*, Volume 27, Number 10, starting on page 3108 and again on page 3115.
2. The Commission held a public hearing on these rules on July 21, 2004 in compliance with IC 4-22. There were no oral comments made at the hearing. The Commission received one letter, which provided comments to one of the proposed rule changes. These comments have been considered by the Commission, but no changes were made to the proposed rules.
3. The promulgation process for the final promulgation of the rule document will take several months.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED.

SECTION 1. SCOPE.

This RESOLUTION applies to each applicant, each licensee, each riverboat license applicant, each operating agent, any person who does business with an applicant or licensee, and any person who is a patron of a Riverboat Gambling Operation.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS.

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

The Commission further adopts any stylistic, grammatical, typographical, or other nonsubstantive changes that the Commission or the Legislative Services Agency may make to the above rules before they are printed as final rules in the *Indiana Register*.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.


This RESOLUTION is effective immediately.
