

RESOLUTION 2005-30

APPROVAL OF THE REQUEST OF DOUBLE WIN POKER, INC. TO WITHDRAW ITS REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF THE GAME OF DOUBLE WIN POKER

The Indiana Gaming Commission (Commission) adopts the following resolution pursuant to the authority granted to it under IC 4-33 and pursuant to 68 IAC 1-2-6.

The Commission has considered the following factors:

1. Double Win Poker, Inc. submitted the game of Double Win Poker for approval for play on Indiana riverboats. Gaming Laboratories International, Inc. ("GLI") reviewed the information submitted by Double Win Poker, Inc. and found that the game is a variation of the traditional game of Poker.
2. Double Win Poker, Inc. received conditional approval of the game for a period of six (6) months, pursuant to Resolution 2004-39, which was adopted by the Commission on August 5, 2004.
3. Majestic Star Casino ("Majestic Star") sponsored Double Win Poker by introducing the game to its casino floor following the conditional approval. Majestic Star advised Commission staff that the game was removed from the casino floor in November of 2004 due to the game's poor performance and lack of player interest.
4. Double Win Poker, Inc. has advised Commission staff that there are no probabilities of future interest in the game. Double Win Poker, Inc. has further requested that its request for approval of Double Win Poker be withdrawn.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION, THAT THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED:

SECTION 1: SCOPE

This resolution applies to all riverboat licensees and Double Win Poker, Inc.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS

The definitions set forth in IC 4-33-2 and 68 IAC apply to this resolution.

SECTION 3: ACTION ON REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF THE GAME DOUBLE WIN POKER.

The Commission hereby;

GRANTS

(GRANTS OR DENIES)

Double Win Poker, Inc.'s request to withdraw its request for approval of the game Double Win Poker.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE

This resolution is effective immediately.


