SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) by and through its Executive Director Ernest E. Yelton and Caesars Riverboat Casino, LLC d/b/a Horseshoe Casino Hotel Southern Indiana (“Horseshoe South”), (collectively, the “Parties”) desire to settle this matter prior to the initiation of a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18(a). The Parties stipulate and agree that the following facts are true:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. 68 IAC 2-6-16(d)(5) states the bill validator shall be equipped with a bill validator drop box to collect the currency inserted into the bill validator. The bill validator drop box shall have a separate lock to access the contents of the bill validator drop box. This key shall not access any other area of the electronic gaming device.
2. On May 29, 2011 a Gaming Agent was contacted by a Surveillance Supervisor regarding a bill validator box without a lock, placed inside a slot machine. Upon further investigation, the Agent found that on May 24, 2011, during the count process, a key had broken inside the lock of the bill validator for a particular slot machine. The Count Team member replaced the box but failed to notice there was not a lock on the box. The missing lock was not discovered until May 29, 2011 during the count process.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Commission staff alleges that the acts or omissions of Horseshoe South by and through its agents as described herein constitute a breach of IC 4-33, 68 IAC and/or Horseshoe South’s approved internal control procedures. The Commission and Horseshoe South hereby agree to a monetary settlement of the alleged violations described herein in lieu of the Commission pursuing formal disciplinary action against Horseshoe South. This agreement is being entered into to avoid the potential expense and inconvenience of disciplinary action.

Horseshoe South shall pay to the Commission a total of \$1,500 in consideration for the Commission foregoing disciplinary action based on the facts specifically


described in each count of this agreement. This agreement extends only to those violations and findings of fact, specifically alleged herein. If the Commission subsequently discovers facts that give rise to additional or separate violations, which are not described herein, the Commission may pursue disciplinary action for such violations even if the subsequent violations are similar or related to an incident described herein.

Upon execution and approval of this Settlement Agreement, Commission staff shall submit this Agreement to the Commission for review and final action. Upon approval of the Settlement Agreement by the Commission, Horseshoe South agrees to promptly remit payment in the amount of \$1,500 and shall waive all rights to further administrative or judicial review.

This Settlement Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. No prior or subsequent understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified or referenced within this document will be valid provisions of this Settlement Agreement. This Settlement Agreement may not be modified, supplemented, or amended, in any manner, except by written agreement signed by all Parties.

This Settlement Agreement shall be binding upon the Commission and Horseshoe South.
