

ORDER 2012-120

**AN ORDER REGARDING THE REQUEST FOR HEARING REGARDING THE
VOLUNTARY EXCLUSION REMITTANCE OF JOHN DOE #11-68**

On September 15, 2011, in Order 2011-143, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) approved remittance of a \$1,350 jackpot seized from John Doe #11-68 for the reason that John Doe #11-68 was a participant in the Voluntary Exclusion Program at the time she won the jackpot at Belterra Casino in Florence, Indiana.

Subsequently, John Doe #11-68 timely filed with the Commission a request for a hearing on Order 2011-143. On May 18, 2012, an Evidentiary Hearing was held on the matter, which John Doe #11-68 attended. Following the Evidentiary Hearing, Administrative Law Judge Michael Cook issued his confidential Order in the matter, upholding the remittance of the jackpot and effectively recommending a denial of John Doe 11-68’s petition for review of Order 2011-143.

COMMISSION ACTION


After reviewing the foregoing and in accordance with IC 4-21.5-3-29, the Commission hereby:

the Administrative Law Judge’s Order. Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-6, this Order will become effective fifteen (15) days after it is served.


