ORDER 2012-207 REGARDING HOOSIER PARK'S REQUEST UNDER INDIANA CODE 4-35-7-11

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") has considered the following factors:

- 1. Hoosier Park, LLC holds a gambling game license under Indiana Code 4-35-5.
- 2. Hoosier Park, LLC operates the Hoosier Park Casino under its gambling game license.
- 3. Indiana Code 4-35-7-11 states that a gambling game licensee may not install more than two thousand slot machines on its premises without the approval of the Commission.
- 4. As of September 30, 2012, Hoosier Park Casino had installed on its premises and was operating one thousand nine hundred three slot machines.
- On October 22, 2012, Hoosier Park Casino requested Commission approval to install an additional two hundred slot machines in addition to the two thousand allowed under IC 4-35-7-11.
- 6. Hoosier Park Casino has represented to the Commission that, during peak seasonal and weekend times, it does not have enough machines to satisfy customer demand.
- 7. Hoosier Park has represented to the Commission that it is developing plans to increase from its current number of machines to 2,200 to meet this customer demand. Approval of an additional two hundred machines in accordance with IC 4-35-7-11 would allow Hoosier Park to implement these plans in the near future.
- 8. Hoosier Park Casino predicts a gaming revenue and slot wagering tax increase if the Commission allows the additional slot machines.

COMMISSION ACTION

The Commission hereby <u>APPROVES</u> / <u>DENIES</u> Hoosier Park Casino's request to install not more than two thousand two hundred slot machines on its premises.
