Mr. Thompson has a history of civic and community involvement such as Play Ball Indiana, Board Member of the Indianapolis Indians Baseball Club, Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Indiana, Central Indiana Community Foundation, Indianapolis Foundation, Indiana University School of Law Board of Visitors, Pan American Games General Counsel, Indiana Sports Corporation Vice President, Indianapolis Capital Improvement Board, Tourism Tomorrow Board of Visit Indy, Indianapolis Bond Bank, and Hoosier Lottery Commission. Mr. Thompson currently serves on the English Foundation and is Vice Chairman for Crown Hill Board of Managers and Foundation. Mr. Thompson graduated from Wittenberg University with a B.A. and from Indiana University School of Law - Bloomington. Mr. Thompson was appointed to the Commission in April of 2022.

Executive Director's Annual Report

Executive Director

It was an honor to be appointed Executive Director by Governor Holcomb in September and a privilege to lead an agency that supports significant contributions to the state's economy. After experiencing negative pandemic related impacts in FY 21, the gaming industry rebounded in FY 22. The industry broke revenue records nationally and Indiana casinos posted significant year over year increases that boosted Indiana tax revenues. Casino wagering and supplemental taxes for FY 22 totaled \$660 million, up 18% from \$560 million in FY 21. Sports wagering taxes were up 38%, from \$23 million in FY 21 to \$31 million in FY 22.

Total state-wide casino win was \$2.5 billion, up from \$2.1 billion the year before. While the racinos and southern casinos experienced significant growth of about 13%, the northern Indiana market grew by 26%. The expansion of the northern market, which grew by \$236 million from \$900 million in FY 21 to \$1.1 billion in FY 22, was fueled primarily by the new Hard Rock Northern Indiana casino in Gary.

The strength of Indiana's gaming industry was also shown in the decision of Caesars to invest a total of \$73.7 million for projects at the state's two racinos in Shelbyville and Anderson. Horseshoe Indianapolis in Shelbyville completed its \$33.7 million expansion in early 2022. The project expanded the gaming floor by 25,000 square feet, increased gaming positions including a 20-table poker room and high limit area, added food and beverage amenities, and created approximately 100 new jobs. A \$40 million expansion of Harrah's Hoosier Park in Anderson began in Spring 2022 with a scheduled July 2023 completion date. The project will add 30,000 square feet to the facility and include additional gaming positions along with a high limit area, enhanced Caesars Rewards and promotional space, a new food outlet on the casino floor, and create 100 new jobs. Track side amenities and the sports book will also be refreshed.

The selection of Churchill Downs as the licensee for the Vigo County casino in December will bring a new gaming venue to the state. The coming biennium will see completion of The Queen of Terre Haute, which will feature an upscale resort-style 120-room hotel, rooftop bar, event space, and a gaming floor comprised of 1000 slots and 34 table games. The total development cost of this project is anticipated to be \$245 million and it will create over 500 new jobs.

Commission staff remained dedicated to preserving the Indiana Gaming Commission's culture of strong and efficient regulation in FY 21, and I'm pleased to report several key promotions. Dennis Mullen relinquished his leadership of the Sports Wagering Division, accepting promotion to the role of IGC General Counsel. Sara Martin was promoted from her role as License Control Counsel to become Director of Sports Wagering and Paid Fantasy Sports, with Bob Opat accepting a promotion to the

position of License Control Counsel. Alex Dudley was promoted from Staff Attorney to Deputy General Counsel. Finally, Carmen Steadham joined the Commission staff, becoming the Director of Human Resources for our law enforcement divisions.

Most notably, however, the Commission saw the departure of our respected chairman, Mike McMains. Chairman McMains led the Commission successfully through many challenges during his tenure and is an exemplary public servant. We are extremely pleased that another highly respected and seasoned leader, Milton O. Thompson, accepted appointment to the chairmanship and welcome his leadership as the Commission continues its mission of overseeing the ever-evolving gaming industry in Indiana.

FY 2022 TAX OVERVIEW

In FY 2022, gaming and sports wagering operations in Indiana generated **\$608,602,682** in wagering tax, **\$51,625,092** in supplemental wagering tax, and **\$31,242,412** in sports wagering tax for a total of **\$691,470,187**. As of June 30, 2022, **\$16,601,816,939** in Wagering, Supplemental Wagering, and Sports Wagering Tax had been reported since inception.

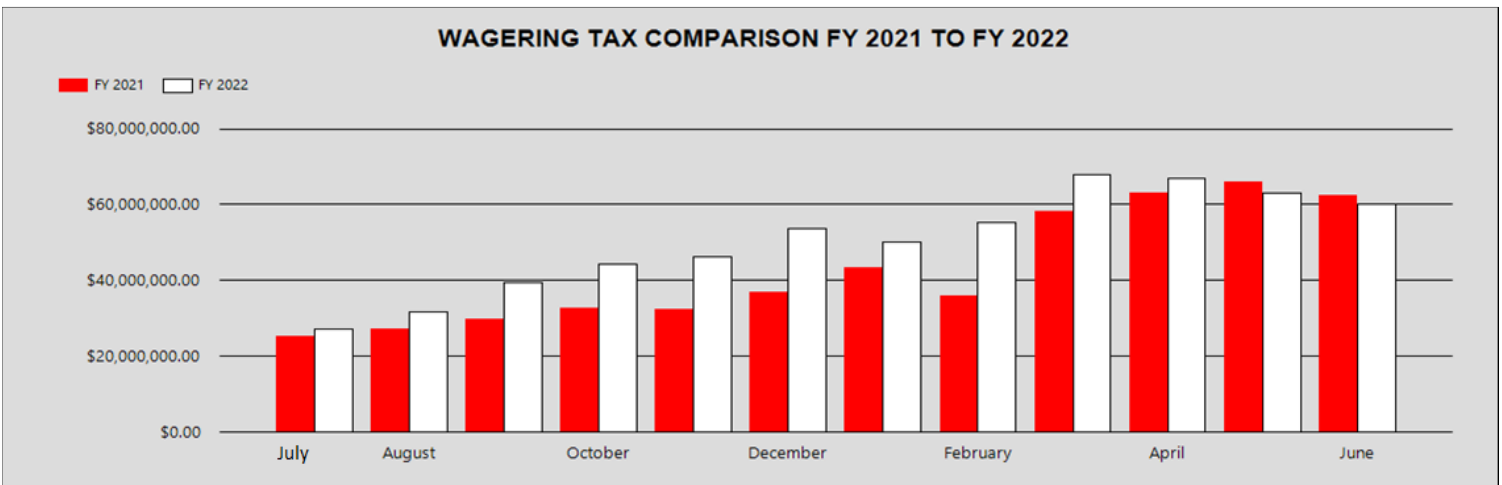

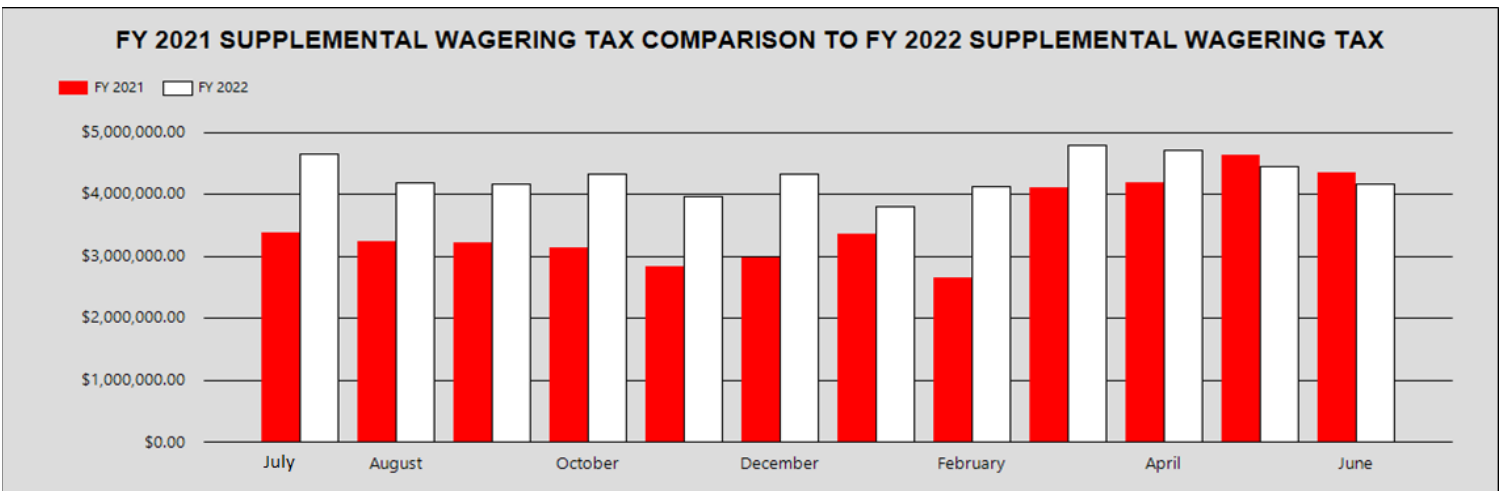

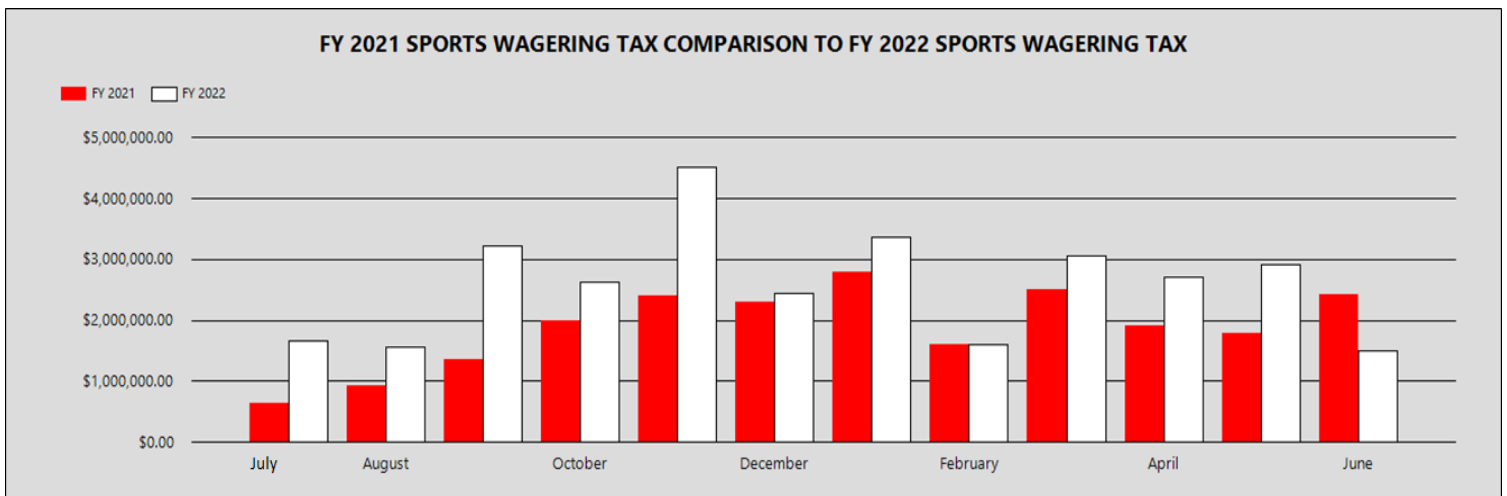

MBE/WBE UTILIZATION

Disparity Study

Statute requires the Commission to establish annual goals for the use of minority and women-owned enterprises (M/WBE). These goals must be derived from a statistical analysis of utilization study of casino contracting and purchases. Such an analysis, also called a disparity study, must be updated every five years.

In keeping with its statutory mandate, an update of the Commission’s study was completed in November 2017. The Indiana University Public Policy Institute completed the study on our behalf, examining the contracting and purchasing practices of Indiana’s casinos from 2012 through 2017. Based upon actual purchase data provided by the casinos and audited by Commission staff, the study period reviewed over \$1.7 billion in spending on goods and services.

In addition to a review of purchasing, also called utilization, a disparity study must also seek to establish capacity, which is a measure of all firms ready, willing and able to provide goods and services to Indiana’s riverboat casinos. The capacity estimate derived from the study is below.

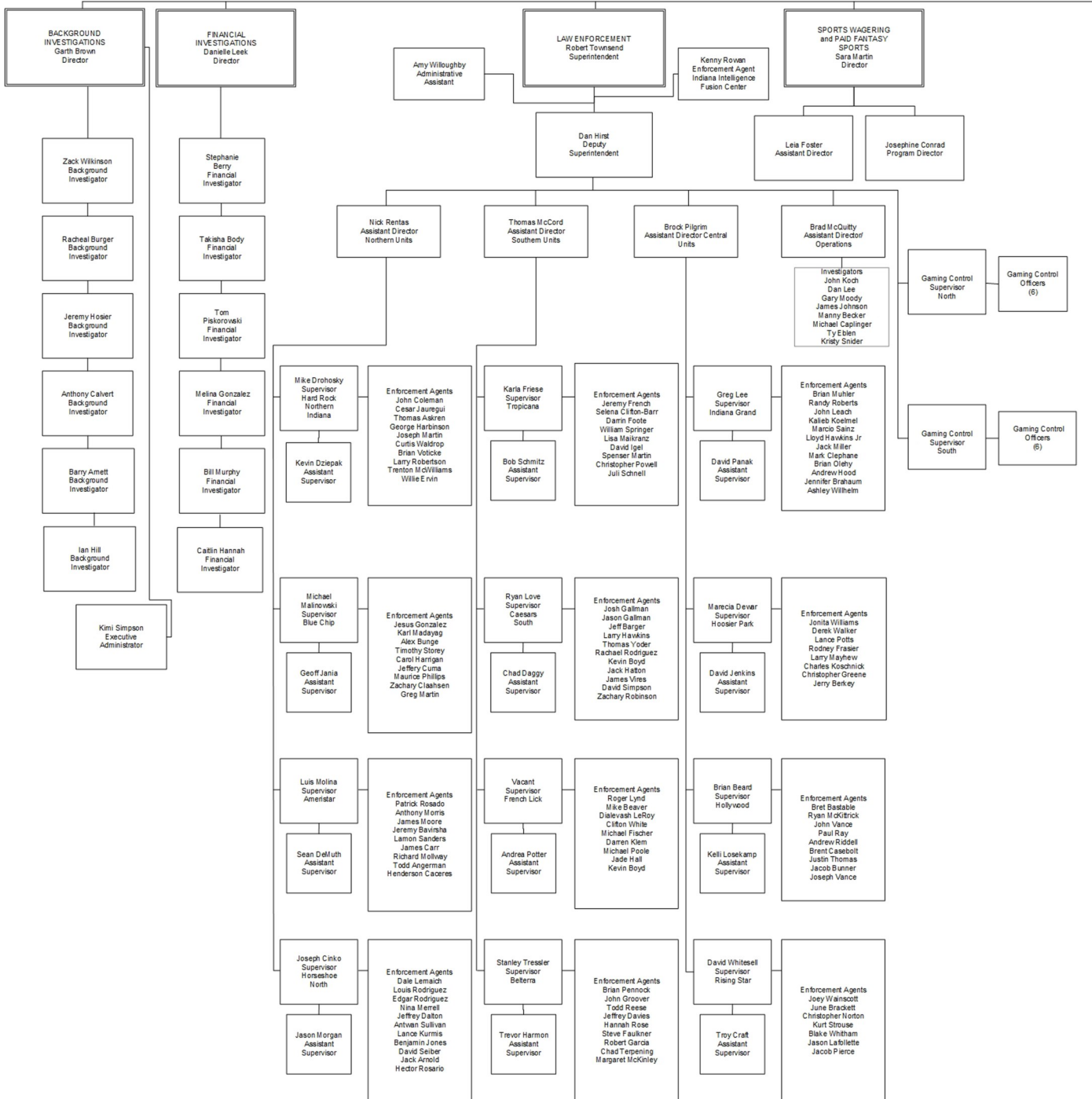

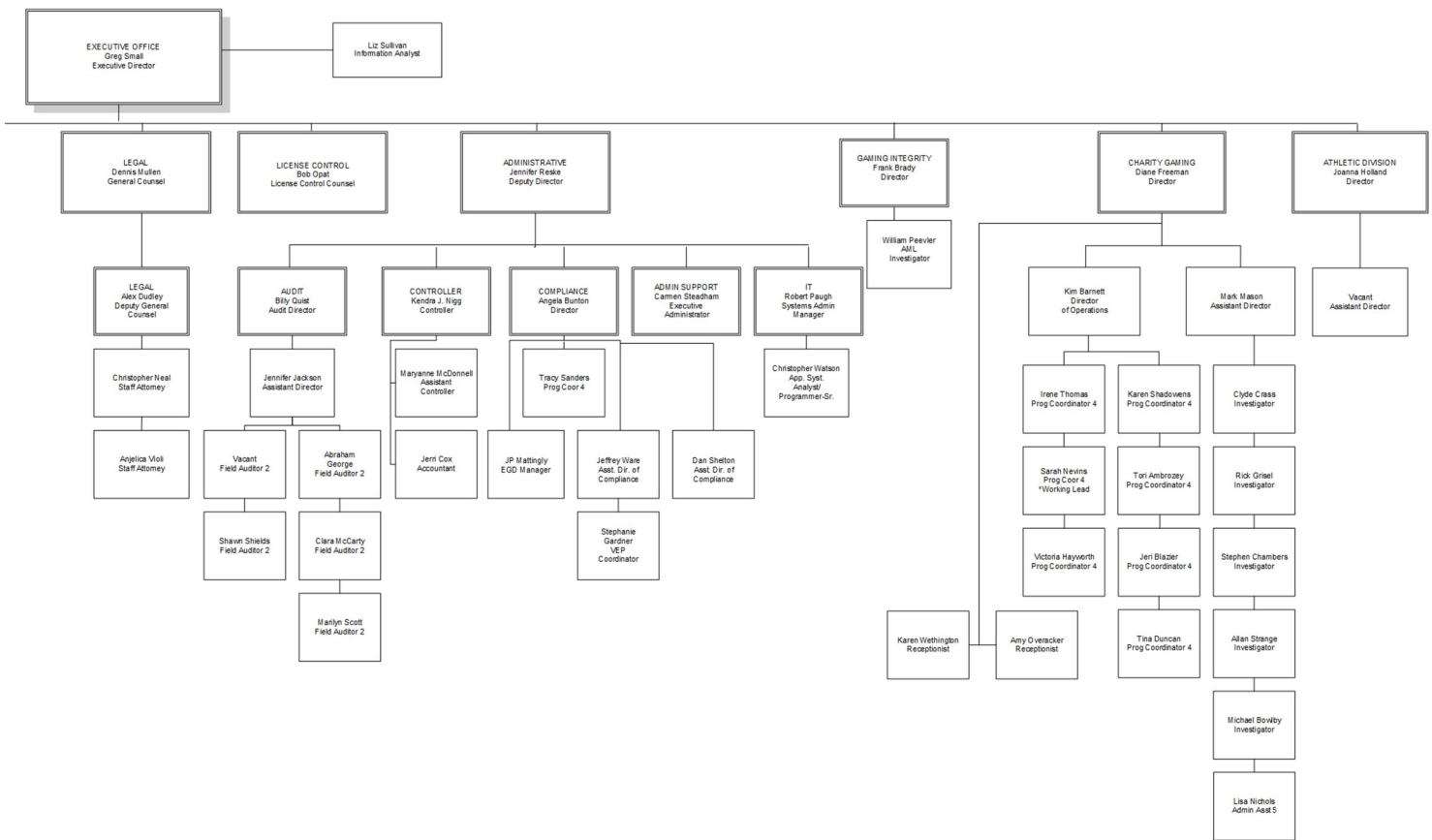

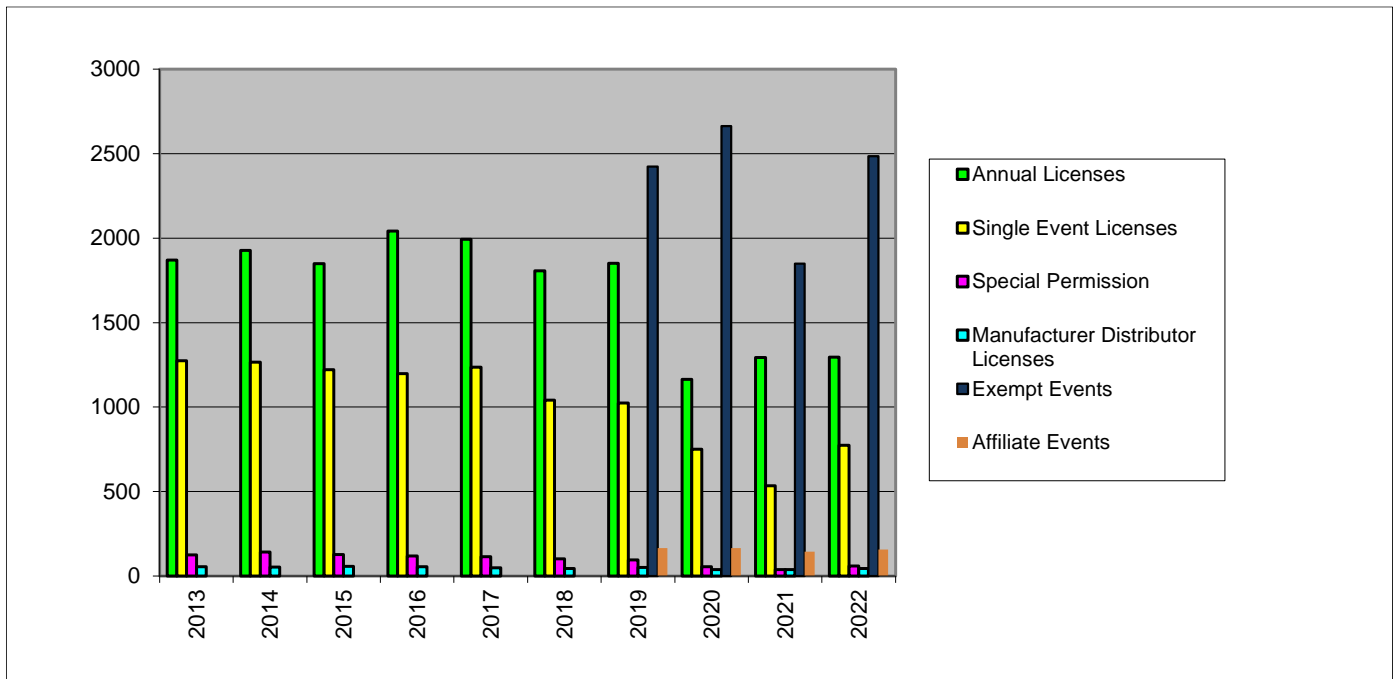

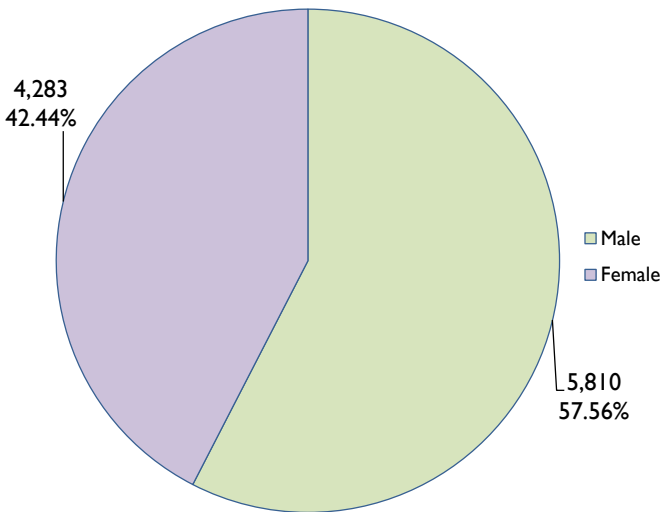
Charity Gaming Licenses Issued



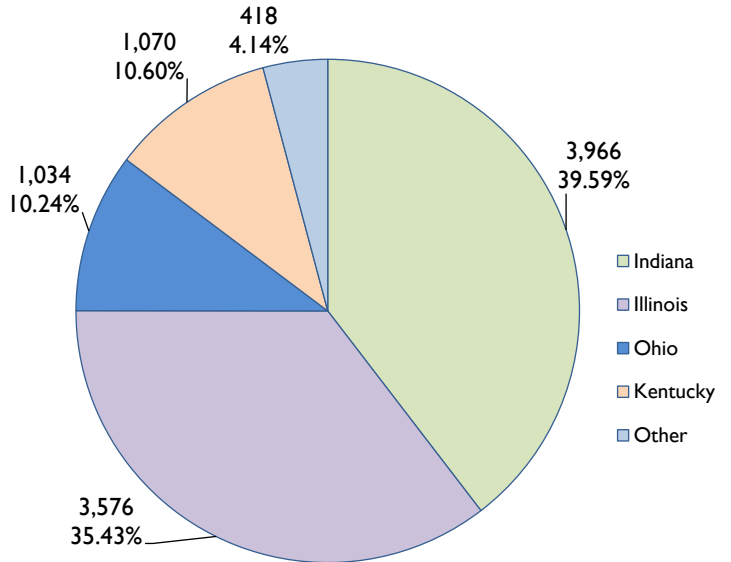
VEP Statistics

There were **6,029** active members from forty (40) different states and two (2) from Canada in the Voluntary Exclusion Program (VEP) as of July 1, 2022. 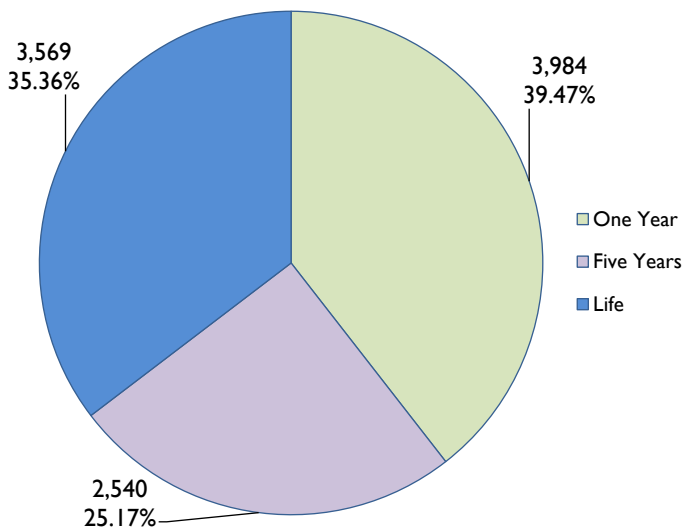
Member Gender



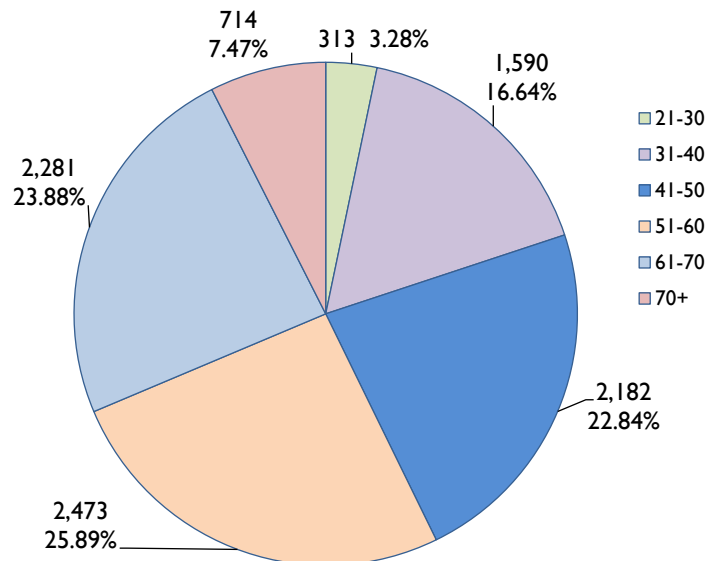
Member State



Member Exclusion Length



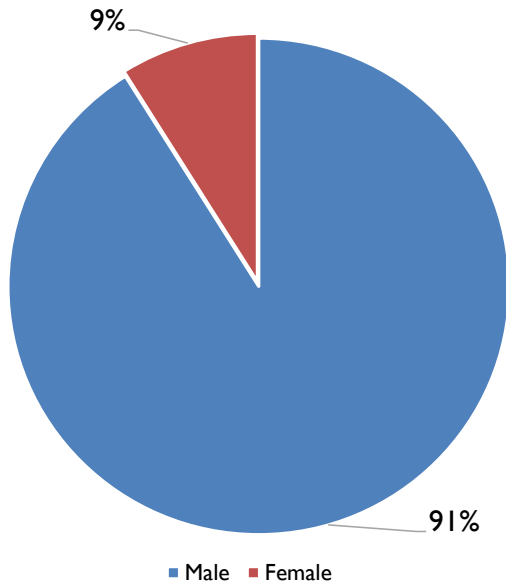

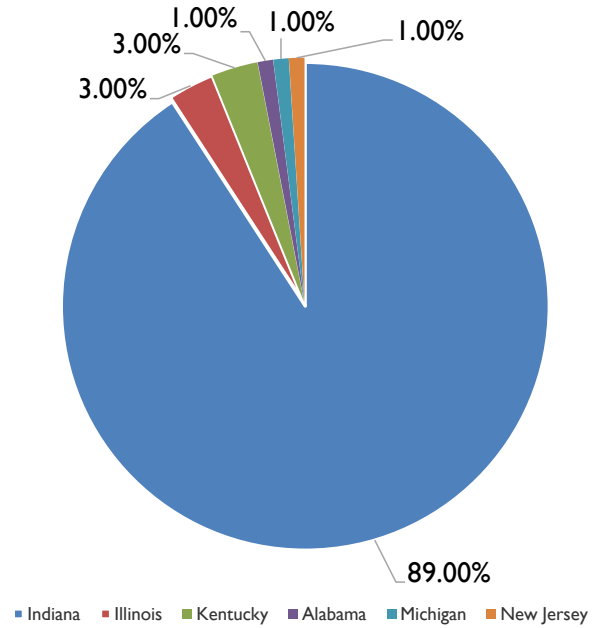
ISRP Statistics

The Commission created and implemented the Internet Self-Restriction Program (ISRP) on September 1, 2019. ISRP only applies to mobile sports wagering. Mobile sports wagering is defined as sports wagering conducted through computers or mobile or interactive devices and accepted in the state of Indiana through an online sports wagering system approved by the Commission. To date, one hundred seventeen (117) individuals have signed up for ISRP; with five (5) individual removing themselves bringing the active total enrollments to one hundred twelve (112). 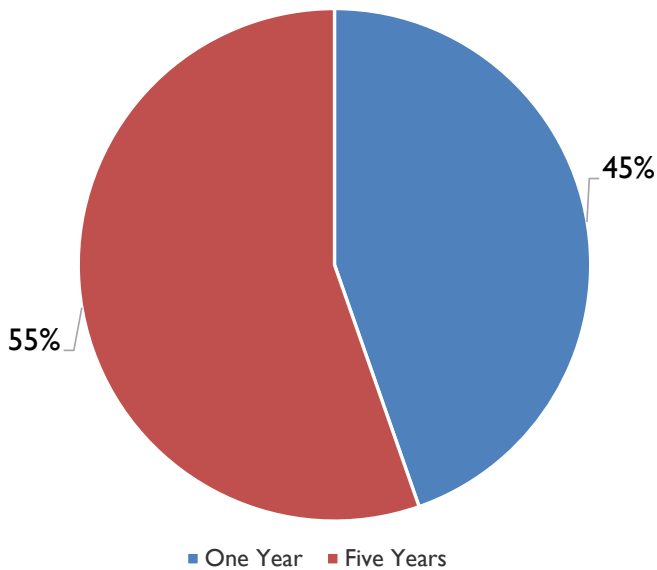
Member Gender



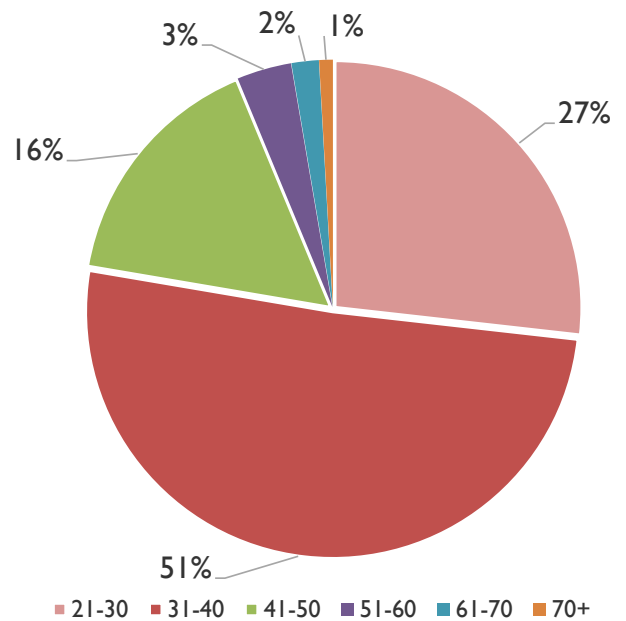
Member State

Gaming Integrity Division

The Gaming Integrity Division, the IGC's newest division, conducts specialized investigations, with particular emphasis on financial matters. This division works closely with casino internal audit, compliance, and finance departments to ensure casinos are employing best practices in maximizing the utilization of data to identify criminal activity. The data utilized includes suspicious activity reports, currency transaction reports, and multiple transaction logs. In its short existence, this division has worked with both federal agencies and local prosecutors and law enforcement agencies in successful prosecutions involving money laundering and other criminal activity.



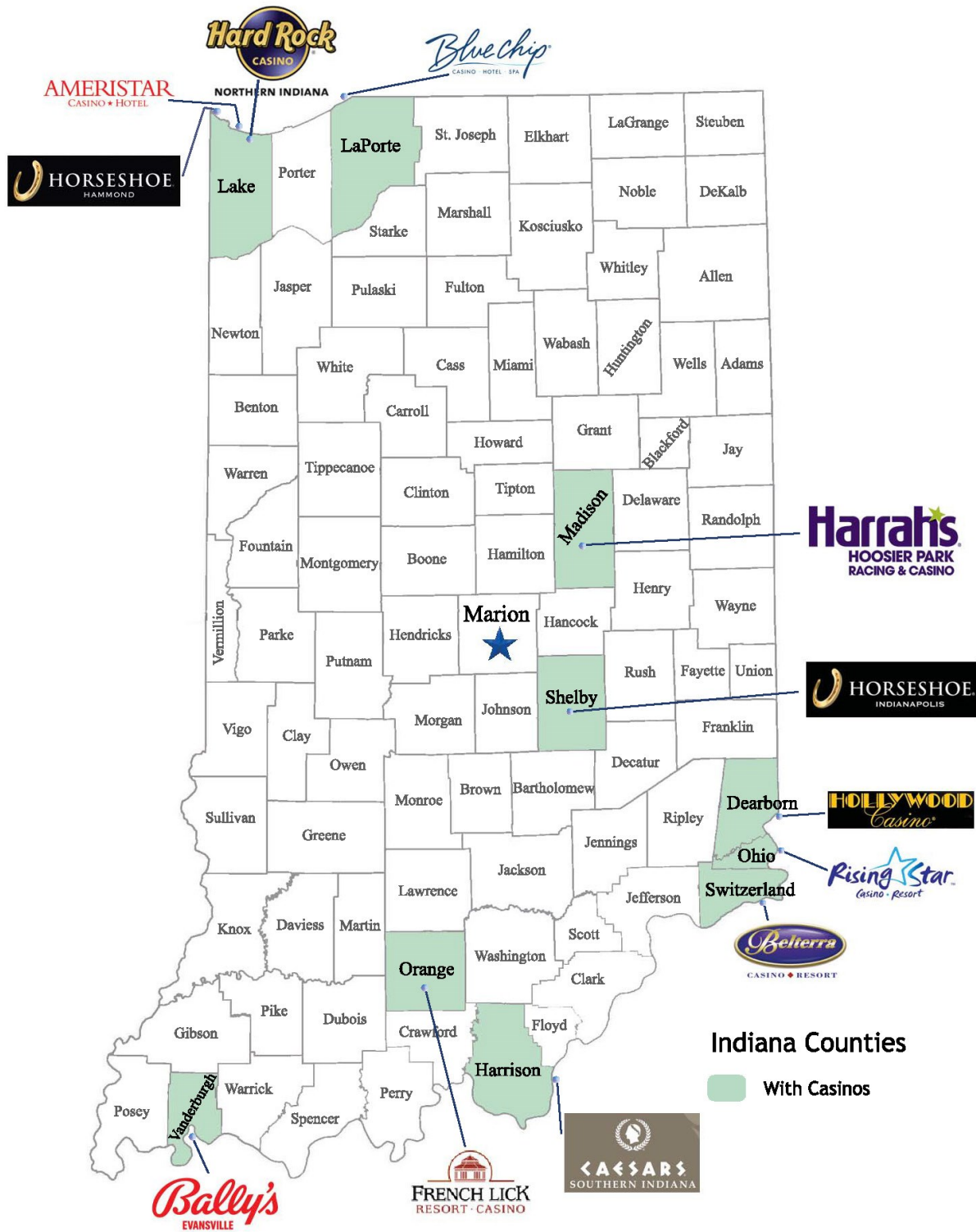
