

ORDER 2021-211
AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION
CONCERNING RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORITY

In accordance with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Ind. Admin. Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") previously issued Certificates of Authority to: (1) Gaming Entertainment (Indiana), LLC d/b/a Rising Star Casino.

A certificate of authority is valid for a period of one year, beginning on the anniversary of the date that certificate holders commence sports wagering operations. Further, in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-38-8-1, a certificate of authority must be renewed annually along with the payment of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) as an annual administrative fee. Each of these certificate holders has requested renewal and paid the required administrative fee. The Commission has determined that the above-named certificate holders remain in substantial compliance with Ind. Code art. 4-33, Ind. Code art. 4-38, and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code and are suitable to hold a certificate of authority. On August 30, 2021, pursuant to a delegation of authority granted by the Commission in Resolution 2019-257, the Executive Director extended the license through a date when the Commission could consider these renewal requests.


The Commission hereby **GRANTS** the renewal of the licenses of each of the following for a period of one year as specified below:

- 1) Gaming Entertainment (Indiana), LLC d/b/a Rising Star Casino: valid November 7, 2021 through November 6, 2022;


Each certificate holder must notify the Commission of its desire to be considered for subsequent certificate renewal at least thirty days before the expiration of the license.
