

ORDER 2021-213

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING THE
PERMANENT SPORTS WAGERING VENDOR LICENSE OF UNIBET INDIANA LLC**

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code ch. 4-38-6 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) has completed its background and financial investigation of Unibet Indiana LLC (“Unibet”) and has determined that Unibet is suitable to receive a permanent sports wagering vendor license.

The issuance of the sports wagering vendor’s license is conditioned upon continued compliance with the following list of requirements:


- 1) Full compliance with all relevant orders, resolutions, and directives issued by the Commission.
- 2) Continued compliance with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code.
- 3) Submission of the required annual administrative fee described under Ind. Code 4-38-6-6. The fee must be submitted on or before one (1) year after the date that the vender begins performing services under a contract with a certificate holder in the conduct of sports wagering operations under Ind. Code art. 4-38 and on each annual anniversary date thereafter. According to the Commission, Unibet commenced sports wagering operations on July 30, 2020.

The Commission has determined that Unibet is substantially compliant with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code and is suitable to hold a sports wagering vendor license. In accordance with and subject to the conditions set forth herein, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** a sports wagering vendor license to Unibet for a period from December 21, 2021 through July 29, 2022.


