ORDER 2022-197 AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATES OF AUTHORITY

In accordance with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Ind. Admin. Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") previously issued Certificates of Authority to: (1) Gaming Entertainment (Indiana), LLC d/b/a Rising Star.

A certificate of authority is valid for a period of one year, beginning on the anniversary of the date that certificate holder commences sports wagering operations. Further, in accordance with Ind. Code § 4-38-8-1, a certificate of authority must be renewed annually along with the payment of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) as an annual administrative fee. Each of these certificate holders has requested renewal and paid the required administrative fee. The Commission has determined that the above-named certificate holders remain in substantial compliance with Ind. Code art. 4-33, Ind. Code art. 4-38, and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code and are suitable to hold a certificate of authority. Prior to this meeting, pursuant to a delegation of authority granted by the Commission in Resolution 2019-257, the Executive Director extended the licenses through a date when the Commission could consider these renewal requests.

The Commission hereby **GRANTS** the renewal of the licenses of each of the following for a period of one year as specified below:

1) Gaming Entertainment (Indiana), LLC d/b/a Rising Star: valid November 7, 2022 through November 6, 2023.

Each certificate holder must notify the Commission of its desire to be considered for subsequent certificate renewal at least thirty days before the expiration of the license.

According to Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-3, this Order is effective fifteen days after it is served.
