SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") by and through its Executive Director Greg Small and IGT (collectively, the "Parties") desire to enter into this settlement agreement ("Agreement") prior to the initiation of a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18(a). The Parties stipulate and agree to the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. 68 IAC 2-6-2 (a) requires that the following may not be used for gaming by any casino licensee prior to the executive director, or the executive director's designee, authorizing their inclusion in the commission's online database of approved items and technologies: (1) Electronic gaming devices (EGD) and any component parts material to gaming activity, including, but not limited to, the following: (A) Random number generators. (B) All game media. (C) Progressive controllers. (D) Bill changers.
- 2. 68 IAC 17-1-3 provides a casino licensee, casino license applicant, or supplier licensee shall use the commission's electronic gaming device database as prescribed by the commission.
- 3. In accordance with 68 IAC 17-1-3, when shipping an item approved under 68 IAC 2-6-2, the supplier is required to provide the Commission with an accurate inventory of each item to be shipped and delivered, including each item's identification code in the Commission's Electronic Gaming Device System ("EGDS").
- 4. On July 1, 2023, a Gaming Agent began an investigation into a shipment violation at Blue Chip Casino.
- 5. On June 29, 2023, Gaming Agents met with the Blue Chip Slot Technical Supervisor and the Regulatory Specialist to inspect a controlled shipment. Request ID 42467 approved in EGDS, listed the contents as one (1) electronic board and five (5) items of software. The package was inspected and determined to be missing the software portion of the shipment.
- 6. On September 11, 2023, a Slot Tech Supervisor at Horseshoe Indianapolis notified Gaming Agents that a controlled shipment outside of the EGD system had been received. The Slot Tech Supervisor provided that she had created a purchase order on August 17, 2023, however, she had not created a request in the EGDS. The shipment was addressed

directly to the property instead of Gaming Agents and contained two (2) AVPS B014-E2504 Boot Chips (software). The Slot Tech Supervisor created two EGD system ID numbers, 42851 and 43284 and submitted them to the Commission for approval. The Items were approved and accepted into inventory.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Commission staff alleges that the acts or omissions of IGT by and through its agents as described herein constitute a breach of IC 4-33, IC 4-35, IC 4-38, and/or 68 IAC. The Commission and IGT hereby agree to a monetary settlement of the alleged violations described herein in lieu of the Commission pursuing formal disciplinary action against IGT.

IGT shall pay to the Commission a total of \$3,000 in consideration for the Commission foregoing disciplinary action based on the facts specifically described in in the Findings of this Agreement. This Agreement extends only to those violations and findings of fact specifically alleged in the Findings above. If the Commission subsequently discovers facts that give rise to additional or separate violations, the Commission may pursue disciplinary action for such violations even if the subsequent violations are similar or related to an incident described in the Findings above.

Upon execution and approval of this Agreement, Commission staff shall submit this Agreement to the Commission for review and final action. Upon approval of the Agreement by the Commission, IGT agrees to promptly remit payment in the amount of \$3,000 and shall waive all rights to further administrative or judicial review.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties. No prior or subsequent understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified or referenced within this document will be valid provisions of this Agreement. This Agreement may not be modified, supplemented, or amended, in any manner, except by written agreement signed by all Parties.

This Agreement may be executed in multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original agreement and both of which shall constitute one and the same agreement. The counterparts of this Agreement may be executed and delivered by electronic mail, facsimile, or other electronic signature by either of the parties and the receiving party may rely on the receipt of such document so executed and delivered electronically as if the original had been received.

This Agreement shall be binding upon the Commission and IGT.
