(ADOPTS) REJECTS

the Findings and of Fact and Recommendation of the hearing officer, and thereby:

APPROVESTREJECTS

the application for felony waiver as to the felonies disclosed by Ashley Quintaine in her February 2024, felony waiver application.

The felony waiver is only for a **LEVEL 2** license to work as a surveillance operator for Terre Haute Casino Resort. Ms. Quintaine may receive a temporary license and be issued a permanent license upon satisfactory completion of a routine licensing investigation and background check. A new felony waiver application must be submitted to the Commission for consideration in the event of a transfer, promotion, or job title change.
