ORDER 2024-46 AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION REGARDING REQUEST FOR WAIVER OF FELONY DISQUALIFICATION FOR CHRISTOPHER JORDAN

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission"), having considered this matter, hereby:

(ADOPTS) REJECTS

the Findings and of Fact and Recommendation of the hearing officer, and thereby:

APPROVES REJECTS

the application for felony waiver as to a felony disclosed by Christopher Jordan in his February 2024, felony waiver application.

The felony waiver is only for a **LEVEL 2** license to work as a dealer for Terre Haute Casino Resort. Mr. Jordan may receive a temporary license and be issued a permanent license upon satisfactory completion of a routine licensing investigation and background check. A new felony waiver application must be submitted to the Commission for consideration in the event of a transfer, promotion, or job title change.
