SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

The Indiana Gaming Commission ("Commission") by and through its Executive Director Sara Gonso Tait and Hoosier Park, LLC ("Hoosier Park"), (collectively, the "Parties") desire to enter into this settlement agreement ("Agreement") prior to the initiation of a disciplinary proceeding pursuant to 68 IAC 13-1-18(a). The Parties stipulate and agree that the following facts are true:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. IC 4-35-7-2 states a person who is less than twenty-one (21) years of age may not be present in the area of a riverboat where gambling is being conducted.
- 2. 68 IAC 1-11-1(c) states a person under twenty-one (21) years of age shall not be present in a casino.
- 3. On March 12, 2018, Security notified Gaming Agents that an underage employee was allowed access to the casino floor to buy food at the Big Deli Restaurant.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Commission staff alleges that the acts or omissions of Hoosier Park by and through its agents as described herein constitute a breach of IC 4-35, 68 IAC and/or Hoosier Park's approved internal control procedures. The Commission and Hoosier Park hereby agree to a monetary settlement of the alleged violations described herein in lieu of the Commission pursuing formal disciplinary action against Hoosier Park.

Hoosier Park shall pay to the Commission a total of \$1,500 in consideration for the Commission foregoing disciplinary action based on the facts specifically described in each count of this Agreement. This Agreement extends only to those violations and findings of fact specifically alleged in the findings above. If the Commission subsequently discovers facts that give rise to additional or separate violations, the Commission may pursue disciplinary action for such violations even if the subsequent violations are similar or related to an incident described in the findings above.

Upon execution and approval of this Agreement, Commission staff shall submit this Agreement to the Commission for review and final action. Upon approval of the Agreement by the Commission, Hoosier Park agrees to promptly remit payment in the amount of \$1,500 and shall waive all rights to further administrative or judicial review.

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties. No prior or subsequent understandings, agreements, or representations, oral or written, not specified or referenced within this document will be valid provisions of this Agreement. This Agreement may not be modified, supplemented, or amended, in any manner, except by written agreement signed by all Parties.

This Agreement shall be binding upon the Commission and Hoosier Park.
